Later in life, our religion is usually accepted as a matter of fact. We, however, question and examine everything except our religious faith, particularly if it is Christianity.

The Christian Bible, being the textbook of Christianity, is a book which I have read many times. I doubt if there is a person who does not shudder while reading its pages, filled as they are with blood-curdling slaughter, rapine and destruction, along with its tales of incest, rape and other vile obscenity. Indeed, after reading the Bible one cannot help but wonder as to the nature of this «God of the Christians».

Almost every Christian home contains the Bible, but it is generally used as a mantelpiece decoration. If it were the custom of the printer to deliver this book with its edges uncut, it would, no doubt, remain so for many years!

Charles Francis Potter, D.D., in his book «The Story of Religion» wrote: «The

Christian Bible may be «the book nobody knows» in America, but the Qur'an is the book everybody reads in Islam.» Yes, indeed, and it is an advantage to Christianity that the Bible is «the book nobody knows.» The Bible was the first cause in leading me away from Christianity.

Having lost all interest in Christianity, I began a study of other world religions, as well as various «ologies» and «isms.» All this was followed by agnosticism and atheism. However, there is, I believe, in mankind an innate certainty deeply rooted which persists in proclaiming the fact that there is Allah, a Divine Creator, Master of the universe. - The act of Salat and its effect on individuals, families and societies have been described in many different ways throughout the Qur'an and in hadith. In one example, Allah S.W.T says: **إِنَّ الصَّلَاةَ تَنْهَىٰ عَنِ الْفَحْشَاءِ وَالْمُنْكَرِ** Surely, Salat **restrains** one from shameful and evil acts
- In another example, Allah S.W.T has told us to seek assistance and tranquillity through Salat **وَاسْتَعِينُوا بِالصَّبَرِ وَالصَّلَاةِ** And seek (Allah's) help with patient **perseverance** and **Salāh**. It is also narrated that,
- "Whenever prophet Muhammad (ﷺ) faced an **important and grim** situation, he would resort to Salat" (Sunan Abi Dawud).

• Our prophet (ﷺ) also emphasised the importance of Salat in the hadith: **أَرَأَيْتُمْ أَنَّ نَهَارًا بَيْنَ أَحَدِكُمْ يَغْتَسِلُ مِنْ كُلِّ يَوْمٍ خَمْسَ مَرَاتٍ هُلْ يَبْقَى مِنْ ذَرَرِهِ شَيْءٌ؟** . قَالُوا لَا يَبْقَى مِنْ ذَرَرِهِ شَيْءٌ . قَالَ «فَذَلِكَ مَثَلُ الصَّلَاةِ الْخَمْسِ يَنْخُوضُ اللَّهُ بِهِنْ الْخَطَايَا» (متفق عليه). "If there was a river at your door and one took a bath in it **five times a day**, would you notice any dirt on him?" They said, "Not a trace of dirt would be left." The Prophet said, "**That is the parable of the five prayers** by which Allah S.W.T removes sins." (Şahih al-Bukhari and Muslim)

• These rewards of Salat are great and vast, however, they can only be attained when proper attention and respect is given to the prayer by ensuring we fulfil its its Shuroot (Conditions), Arkaan (Pillars) and Adaab (Mannerisms).

• The word «**صلوة Salāh**» (Prayer) originates from its root «**صلحة Silah**» which means «connection». That is because it **connects the servant with his Creator**, that it brings him near His Mercy and connects him to His Generosity and His Paradise.

ESTABLISHING THE PRAYER – PART 2

- In the Qur'an, Allah S.W.T always uses the phrase **Iqāmat As Salāh**

(Establishing the Prayer) rather than **Adā As Salāh** (Performing the Prayer). This is because **أَدَاءُ الصَّلَاةِ** refers to just performing the **physical** and ritualistic aspects of the prayers, while **إِقَامَةُ الصَّلَاةِ** goes beyond the mere performance of its prescribed movements, by fulfilling all its **conditions** (**شرُوط**) and **pillars** (**أَركان**). This is what leads to one **experiencing the feeling of perfect submission and humility** before Allah S.W.T.

ESTABLISHING THE PRAYER - PART 3

- To achieve iqamat as-Salāh, fulfilment of its conditions (**شرُوط**) **prior** to the Salat must be followed by implementing its pillars (Arkaan) **during it**, through performing the Salat's bowings, prostrations, standings, recitations, and the glorification of Allah S.W.T with **perfect heedfulness and tranquillity**.

• However, failing to correctly perform any Pillars, Waajibaat or Sunan due to slackness or neglect is compared to **stealing**. Our prophet (ﷺ) said: **أَسْوَأُ النَّاسَ سَرِقَةُ الَّذِي يَسْرُقُ مِنْ صَلَاتِهِ** قالوا يَا رَسُولَ اللَّهِ وَكَيْفَ يَسْرُقُ مِنْ صَلَاتِهِ يُتْبَعُ زَوْعَهَا وَلَا سُجُودَهَا

The worst kind of thief is one who steals from his prayer. The companions said, "O Prophet of Allah, how can someone steal from their prayer?" He (SAW) said, "**He does not fulfill the ruku of the prayer nor its sujood**". (Muwatta' Mâlik)

Common Mistakes Occur During:

1. Standing straight **after** bowing (Ruku)
2. Sitting **between** the 2 prostrations (Sujood)
3. and having **tranquillity** (**خشوع**) during the entire Salat.
4. Perfecting the **Sajdah**.

ESTABLISHING THE PRAYER - PART 4

On the Day of Judgment **إِنَّ أَوَّلَ مَا يُحَاسَبُ بِهِ الْعَبْدُ يَوْمَ الْقِيَامَةِ مِنْ عَمَلِهِ** **صَلَاتَةٌ فَإِنْ صَلَحْتُ فَقَدْ أَفْلَحْتُ وَأَنْجَحْتُ وَإِنْ فَسَدَتْ**

فَقَدْ خَابَ وَخَبِيرٌ، فَإِنْ أَنْتَقَصْ مِنْ فَرِيضَتِهِ شَيْءٌ قَالَ الرَّبُّ عَزَّ وَجَلَّ : اُنْظِرُوا هُنَّ لَعْبَدِي مِنْ تَطْوِعٍ فَيُنْكَلِّ بِهَا مَا أَنْتَقَصَ مِنْ فَرِيضَتِهِ ؟ ثُمَّ يَكُونُ سَائِرُ عَمَلِهِ عَلَى ذَلِكَ

"The first thing for which a person will be brought to account on the Day of Resurrection will be his prayer. If it is sound, he will be successful, and if it is lacking in any way, he will be doomed. If his obligatory prayers are lacking, the Lord will say: **"Look and see whether My slave has any voluntary prayers** (sunnah, Naafilah) which may be used to make up what is lacking in his obligatory prayers." Then all his deeds will be examined and dealt with in the same way." (Sunan al-Tirmidhi no. 413)

MORE BENEFITS

(2) WASHES AWAY SINS

Everyone commits sins; however, Allah S.W.T has provided, in prayer, a way to wipe out those sins. Allah S.W.T says: (Surah Hûd 11:114) **وَأَقِيمِ الصَّلَاةَ ... إِنَّ الْحُسْنَاتِ يُذْهِبُنَّ السَّيْئَاتِ** And establish As-Salat, ... Verily, the good deeds remove the evil deeds.

• Abu Huraira reported that the Messenger of Allah S.W.T (ﷺ) said: **أَلَا أَدُلُّكُمْ عَلَى مَا يَمْخُونُ اللَّهُ بِهِ الْخَطَايَا وَتَبَرُّعُهُ بِالْمَرْجَابِ** **قَالُوا يَا رَسُولَ اللَّهِ . قَالَ إِسْبَاغُ الْوُضُوءِ عَلَى الْمُكَارِهِ وَكُثْرَةُ الْحُطْطَهُ إِلَى الْمَسَاجِدِ وَأَتَيْتُهُ الْأَرْبَاعَ** **فَأَنْتُبَاطُ الْصَّلَاةَ بَغْدَ الصَّلَاةِ فَلَمْ يَكُنْ لَّهُ الرَّبَاطُ** «Should I not direct you to something by which Allah S.W.T **obliterates the sins and elevates (your) ranks.**» They said: «Yes, O Messenger of Allah S.W.T». He said, «**Performing Wudu properly**, even in difficulty, **frequently going to the mosque**, and **waiting eagerly for the next Salat (prayer)** after a Salat is over; indeed, that is Ar-Ribat/mindfulness» (Sahih Muslim).

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UMAR (R.A)

The Second Rightly Guided Caliph Umar ibn Al-Khattab A man of his word

(Part One)

Praise be to Allah, and prayers and peace be upon the Prophet Mohammad (S.A.W) and his sanctified and dedicated Companions (R.A.), as well as all their followers till the Day of Judgment.

The life of Al Farooq Umar ibn Al-Khattab (R.A.) is a shining page of Islamic history, which outshines and supersedes all other histories. The history of all nations put together

does not contain even a part of what his life contained of noble conduct, glory, sincerity, struggle, and calling others for the sake of Allah.

His Physical Appearance:

With regard to his physical characteristics, he was white with a reddish complexion. He was muscular, tall, solid and bald. He was very strong, not weak or puny. When he walked, he walked quickly, when he spoke, he spoke clearly, and when he struck, he caused pain.

Early Life:

Umar spent half of his life in the pre-Islamic society (Jahiliyah), and grew up like his peers of Quraish, except that he has an advantage over them in that he was one of those who had learned to read, of whom there were very few. He bore responsibility at an early age, and had a very harsh

upbringing in which he knew no type of luxury or manifestation of wealth. From his early youth he also excelled in many kinds of sports, such as wrestling, riding and horsemanship.

Umar (R.A.) was wise, eloquent, well spoken, strong, tolerant, noble, persuasive and clear of speech, which made him qualified to be an ambassador for Quraish, to speak up for them before the other tribes. Ibn Al-Jawzi made mention of the very prominent position **Umar (R.A.)** enjoyed in Makkan society during the pre-Islamic era. He said: "The role of ambassador fell to Umar ibn Al-Khattab. If there was a war between Quraish and another tribe, they would send him as an **ambassador**, and if another tribe was boasting against them, they would send him to respond in kind, and they were pleased with him."

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
